The Robotics Campus is a collaboration between the city of Riihimäki and the region's educational institutions and businesses.

Our mission is to develop and implement robotics education from early childhood education through to higher education. Robotics Campus offers training and education to students, teachers and other professionals to learn about technology, robotics and AI.

In basic education, children gain a broad understanding of robotics and AI through a minimum of 250 hours of robotics teaching. They design, build and program robots, learning future skills: teamwork, problem solving and critical thinking.

Welcome to the Robotics Campus! The first steps towards Robotics Campus were taken in 2014. During your visit, you will hear about the robotics curriculum and how it has been integrated into basic education, and learn about teachers' continuing education and learning environments used in Riihimäki. In addition, you will learn what kinds of administrative structures help to develop and implement Riihimäki's robotics education curricula from early childhood and onwards.
