

Culture and history in Häme




Häme Castle

- Best preserved medieval brick castle in the Nordic countries, built in 13th century.
- Next to Häme Castle two other museums:
 - The Prison - Finland's largest prison museum
 - Museo Militaria museum is showcasing the history of Finnish war history.
 - Escape from castle game and the hidden places of the castle guided tour.
- Historical Ox Road from Turku Castle to Häme Castle
- Old Churches
- Old historical and medieval churches in Häme region:
 - The Holy Cross Church in Hattula
 - Church of St. Lawrence in Janakkala
 - Vanaja Church in Hämeenlinna
 - Loppi Old Church – Santa Pirjo

Finnish Design and Fashion




Häme is famous of glass design, glassblowing history and textile industry.

- Torronsuo National Park
 - Piece of Lapland one hour from Helsinki. Torronsuo is Finland's deepest swamp.
